Standard No. 1: Foundational Knowledge and Standards No. 24: Assessment Elements for Section I: Educational Outcomes were found Non-Compliant on the basis of the program's NAPLEX® pass rate (as noted on the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) website), which may indicate a lack of the necessary foundational knowledge, content delivery, and/or assessment related to knowledge attainment of the expected educational outcomes.

Standard No. 21: Physical Facilities and Educational Resources was found Non-Compliant due to a lack of access to adequate and appropriately equipped physical and educational facilities.

A focused visit will be conducted in spring 2024 to evaluate Standards No. 1, 21 and 24.
