



## ACCREDITATION COUNCIL FOR PHARMACY EDUCATION

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### MEMO REGARDING REVISED POLICIES AND PROCEDURES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 26, 2024

As a result of actions of the ACPE Board of Directors at its January 2024 meeting, the following changes were made to the Policies and Procedures for International-Accreditation, International- Preaccreditation and Provisional International-Accreditation. The changes are effective immediately (January 26, 2024):

- The qualifier (designation) of (\*online evaluation) has been changed to (online evaluation);
- Probation is no longer classified as an Adverse Action; hence is not appealable;
- Minor changes were made to the ACPE Travel Policy to incorporate policy changes that had already been implemented but not yet included in the Travel Policy document; namely, the requirement for host institutions for on-site evaluation visits to reimburse ACPE for business class travel and business class hotels;
- The Terms of Reference of the International Commission were revised.
